October 17th 1U Sunday Worship Service 9:30AM

- **LOCATION:** Courtyard between the Sanctuary and Gore Hall.
- **TIME: 9:30AM.** Please arrive early enough to allow all to settle in comfortably.
- **SEATING: Please bring your own chair if at all possible, as we have a limited number of chairs for outdoor use.** Groups will be seated as they arrive, beginning in the front rows.
- **REGISTRATION:** Please use the link below to complete the registration. **All planning to attend must complete the registration form or call the church office** at 407-898-3621 Ext. 5. When leaving a message, please include the number attending and if you will need seating. **Registrations will be confirmed in the order received until we reach capacity.**
- **CHILDCARE:** We are unable to provide childcare for the 17th. TBA for future services.
- **ALTERNATIVE TO IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE:** The in-person service will also be live streamed on YouTube at 9:30am. Link will be included in the Weekly Update.
- **10:30AM TAPED SERVICE:** Plans are underway for the service to be taped and shown again at 10:30am, followed by

virtual Fellowship. Update and links will be included in the Weekly Update.

- **IN-PERSON FELLOWSHIP:** There will be very limited refreshments and opportunity to gather in-person for Fellowship following the service. Please bring your own water bottle and snacks, if desired. Coffee flavored and tea flavored candy will be provided.
- **CANCELLATION:** In the event of inclement weather, cancellation notices will be posted on the 1U website and our Facebook page by 7:45am on the day of the service.
